To see home composting in action, Sayers Croft Field Centre in Ewhurst is home to Surrey's first home composting demonstration centre. Built in partnership with Sayers Croft, Waverley Borough Council and Waste No More, the centre shows how organic kitchen and garden waste breaks down into a valuable product, which can be used as an excellent alternative to peat or chemical fertilisers. The centre will be used as an education facility to increase home composting throughout Waverley, with free admission to all residents.
